

Here are some logic symbols that you can use in your writing (e.g., a Word document or e-mail): $\therefore \sim \bullet \vee \supset \equiv \exists \diamond \square$. Highlight the symbol you want to use, click copy, go to Word or your e-mail program or whatever, and click paste. After you paste the symbol, you may have to reset font and font-size to match the rest of your writing. This is quick-and-dirty, but it works so long as your computer is fairly recent and uses Unicode fonts.
